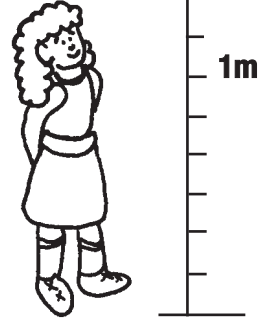

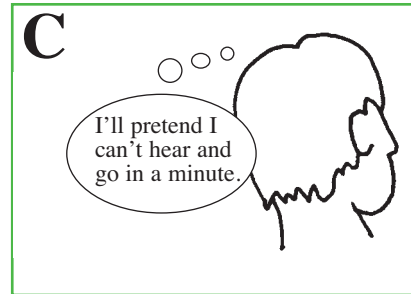

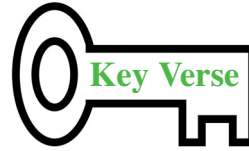

The **Key Verse** tells us that the Lord Jesus was tempted in every way, just as we are, but He never sinned.

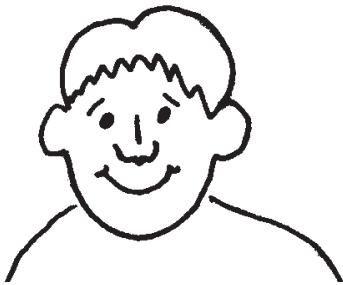

“Well, I don’t know,” said Ben. “Do you think we should?”



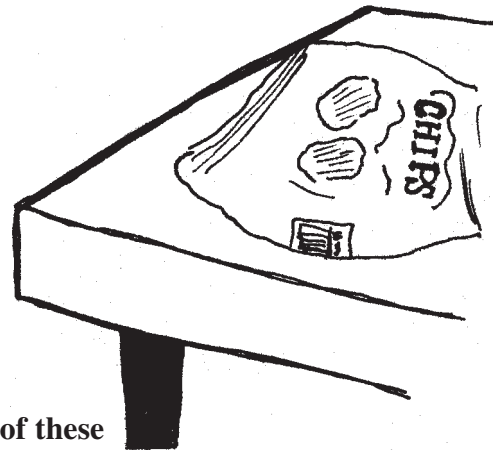
Ben was being tempted to do wrong.

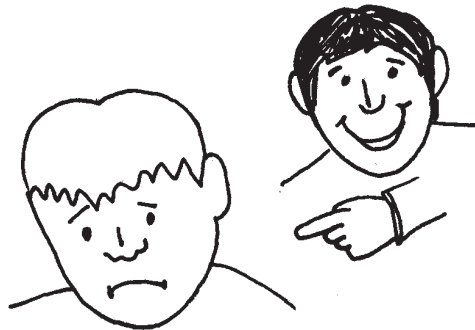

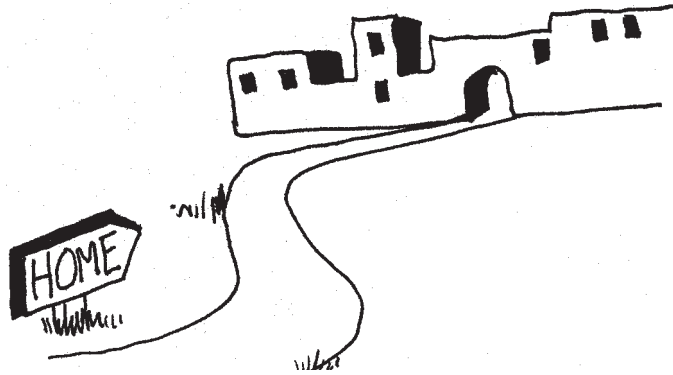

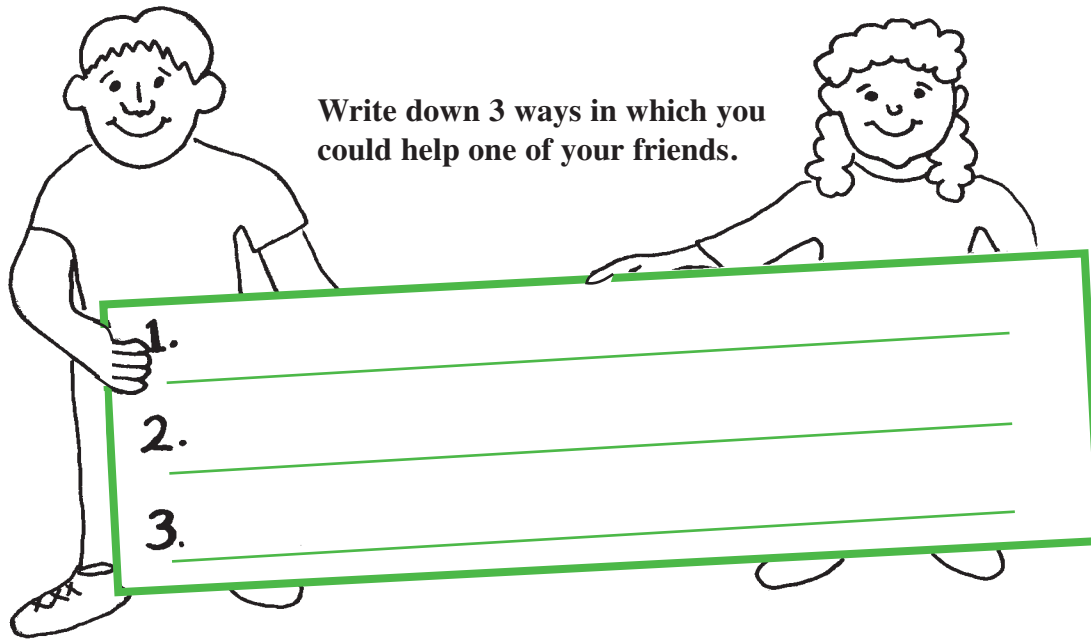
