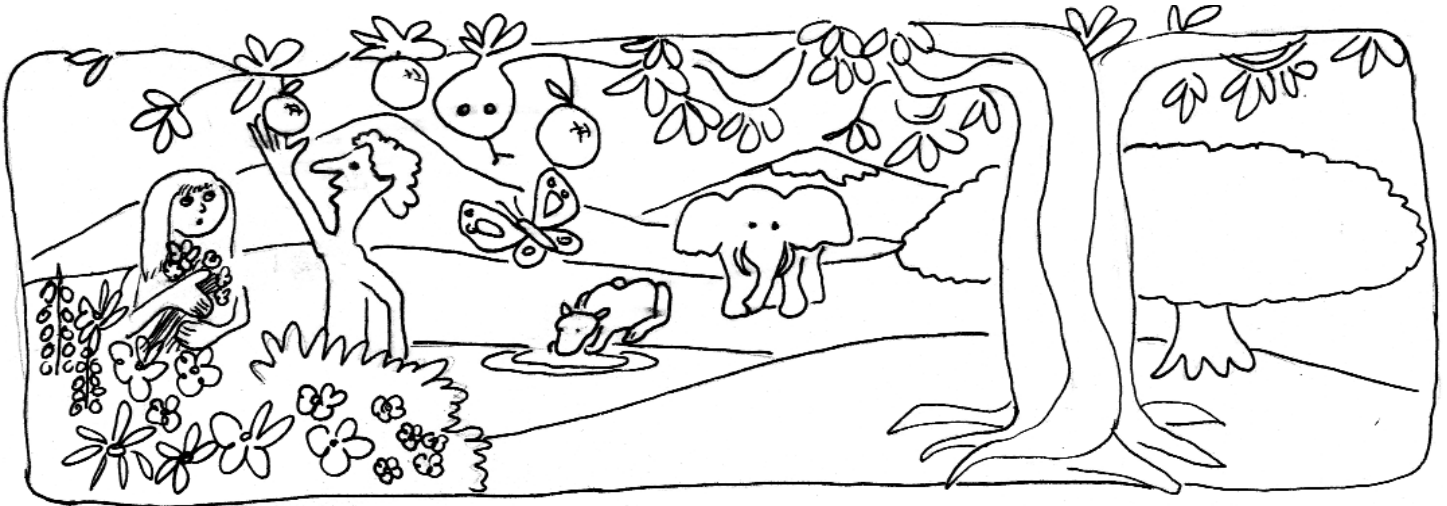


Genesis 2: 4-25

Sin coming into the world

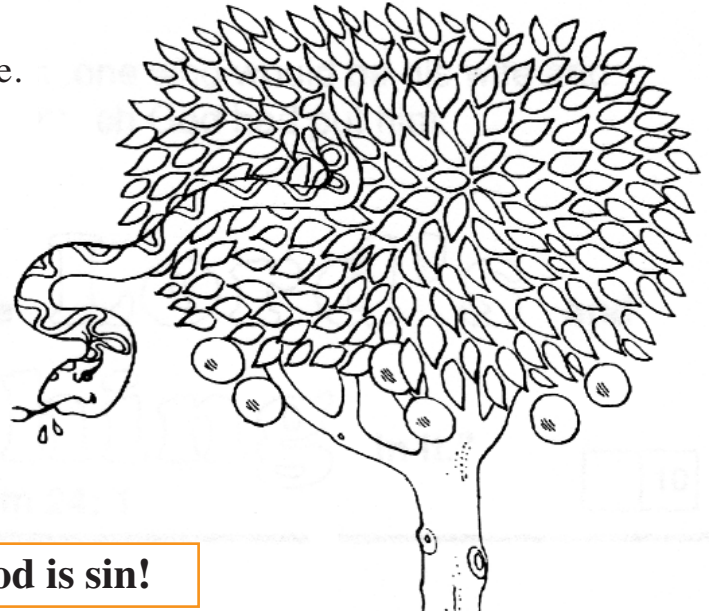
