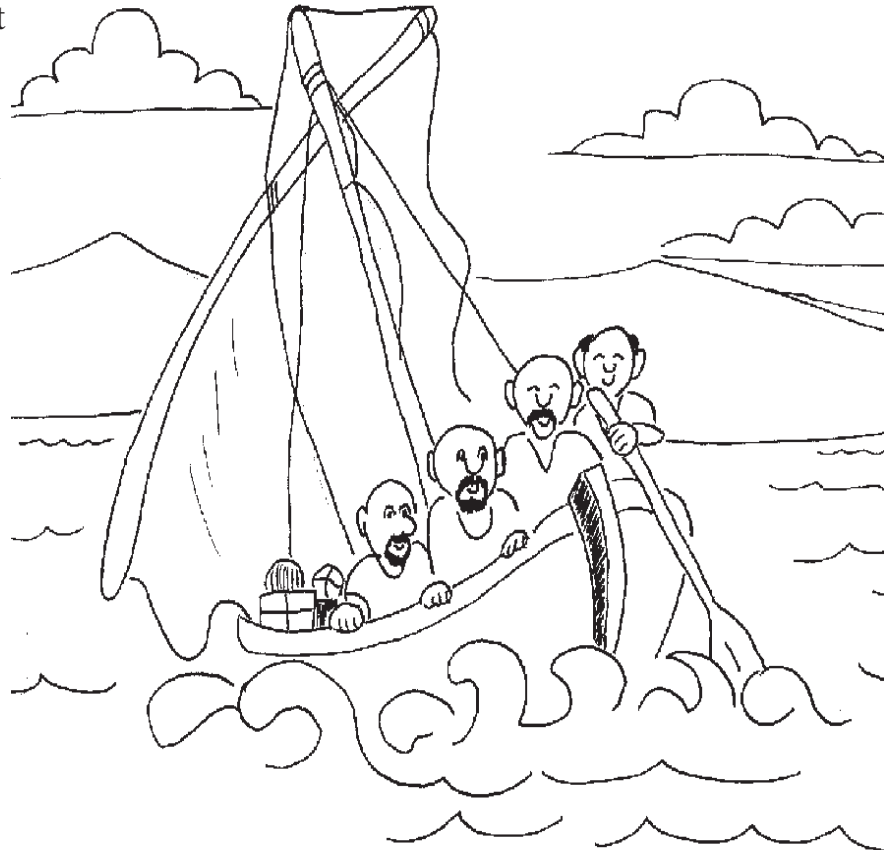
God wanted Barnabas and Saul to go to other places to tell people about the Lord Jesus. So they went on a boat to an island called Cyprus.

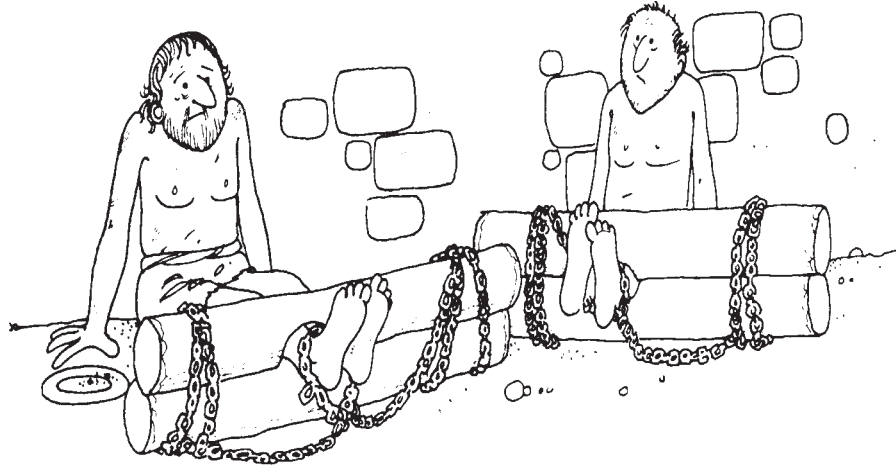
