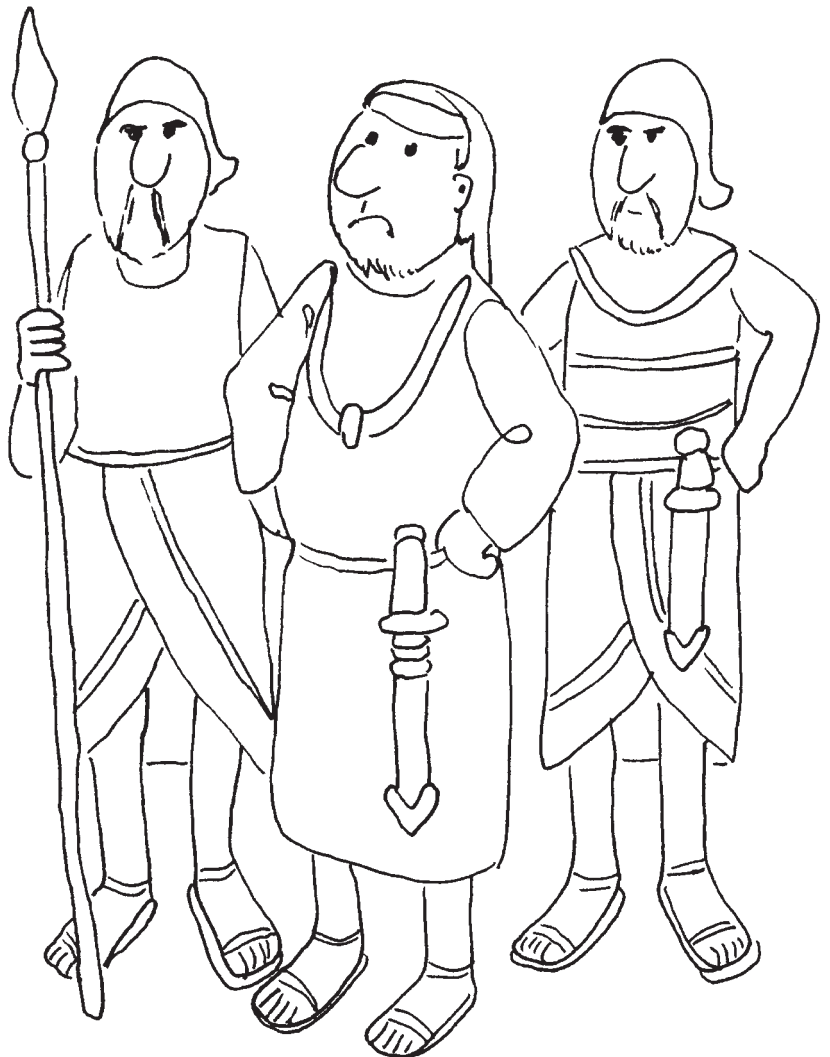
When Peter saw Jesus being taken away, he was angry. He took a sword and attacked one of the men who was with Judas. In the fight, Peter cut off this man's ear.

Peter was frightened and told a lie. "I don't know what you're talking about", he said.

*This true story is about:
Peter loving Jesus*

The Lord Jesus had died on the cross. His body had been put in the tomb or cave. On the first Easter Sunday morning He came alive!

Many of the disciples saw Him that day.

Some days later, Peter and the disciples went fishing. They fished all night but caught nothing. In the morning they saw someone on the shore. It was the Lord Jesus, but they didn't know Him.
