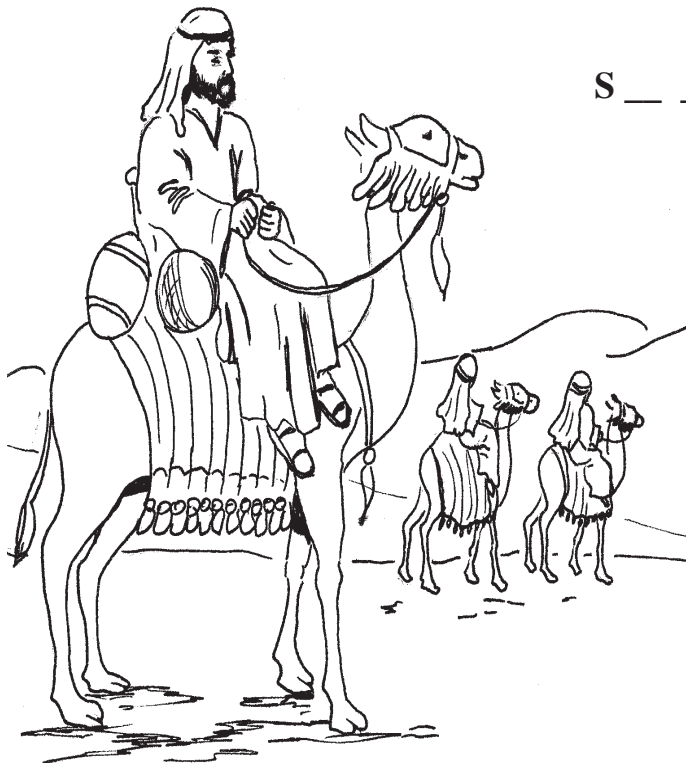
Genesis 12: 1-9

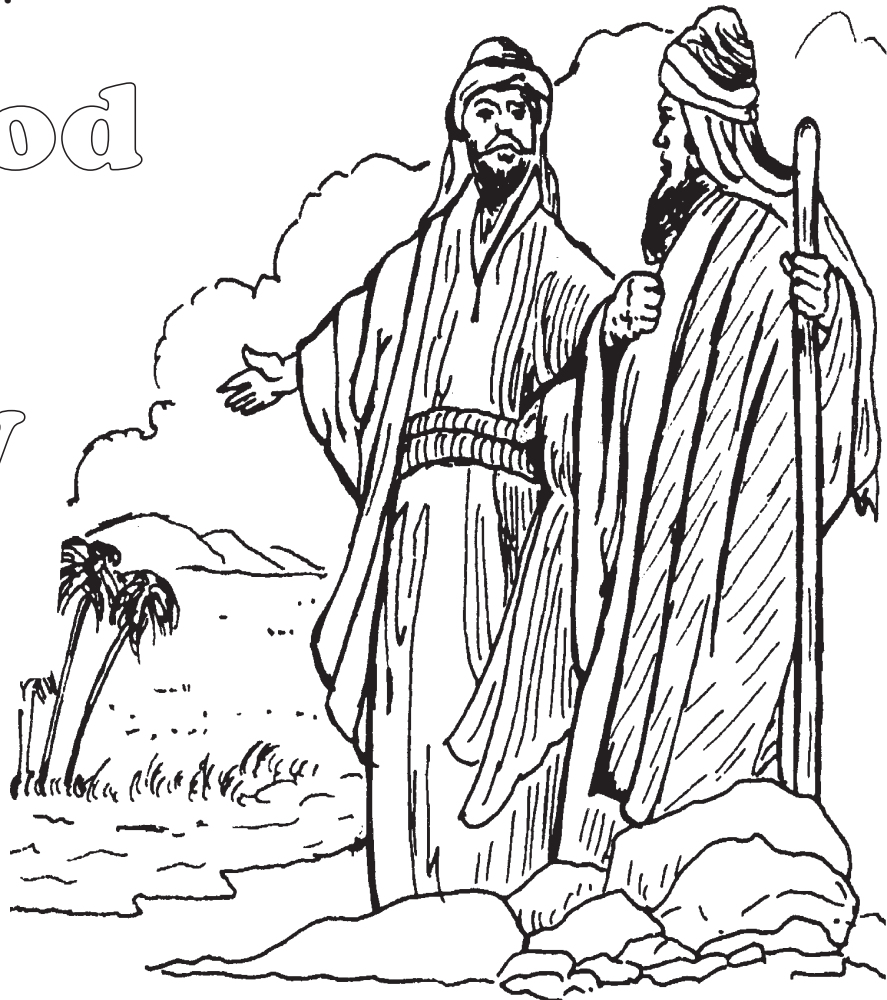
