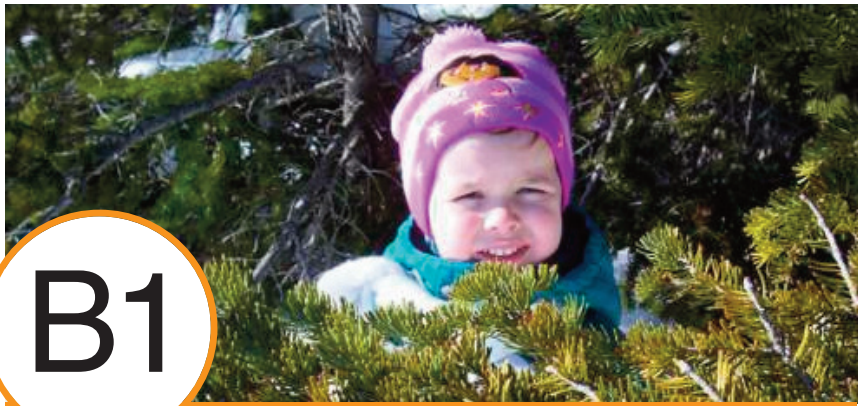

Jesus went into the desert after His baptism. It is a very hot and dry place with hardly anything growing. Jesus did not eat for the forty days He was there. So, He was very hungry.

The devil told Jesus to turn the stones in the desert into bread. Jesus knew this would not please God, His Father, so He did not do it.

Then the devil took Jesus up to a high mountain and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world. He promised to give Him all these, if only Jesus would worship him. Again Jesus knew this was wrong, for God's Word said you should worship only God.
