

For the Hebrews (or Israelites) God made a way of being saved from this terrible plague.


All the Hebrew families were to put the blood of a lamb on the two side posts and on the top of their door frame. Then they were to go into their house, and stay inside all night.

God promised, "When I see the blood, I will pass over you." That meant they would be completely safe on the night of the plague.

Soon thousands of Israelites were on their way towards the Red Sea.


