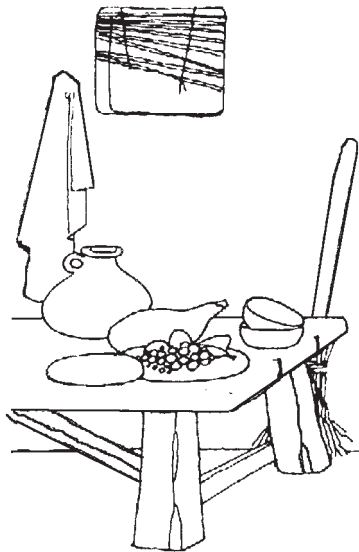
Lesson No. 1 - Learning from Jesus

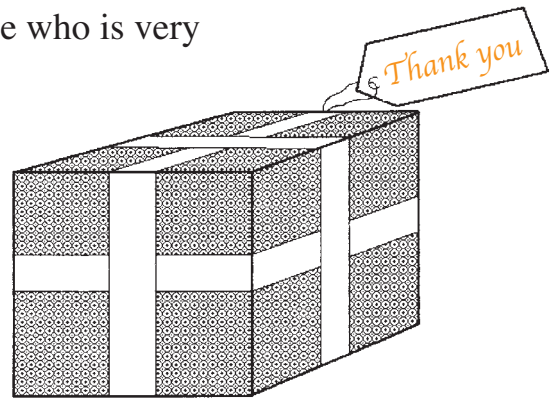
Have you ever given a 'Thank you' present to someone who is very good to you?

Mary and Martha were so pleased that Jesus had given them back their brother. They wanted to have a feast for Him.

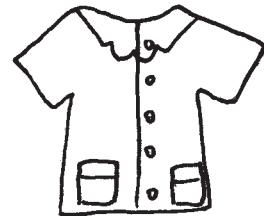
There were lots of people invited to the feast but Jesus was the most important Person.
