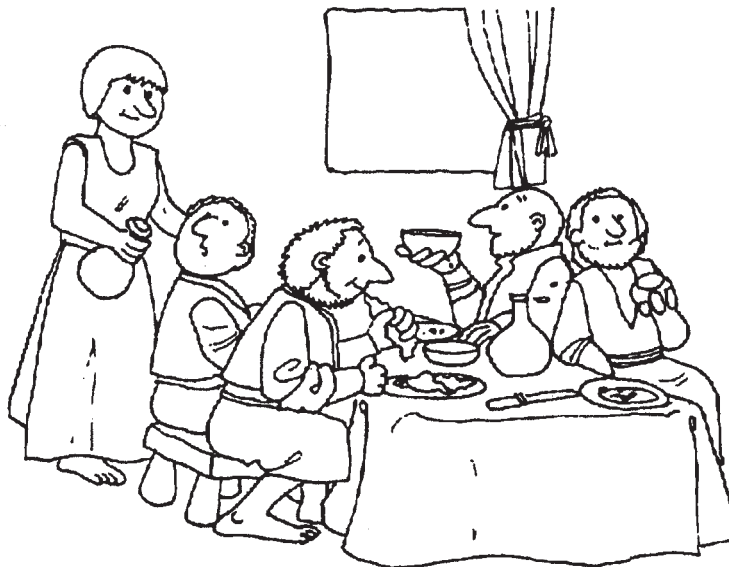

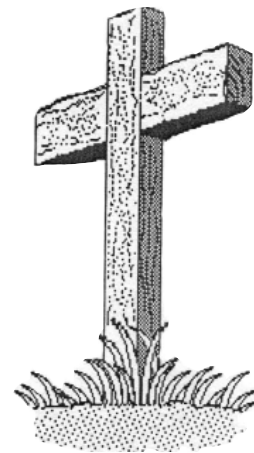

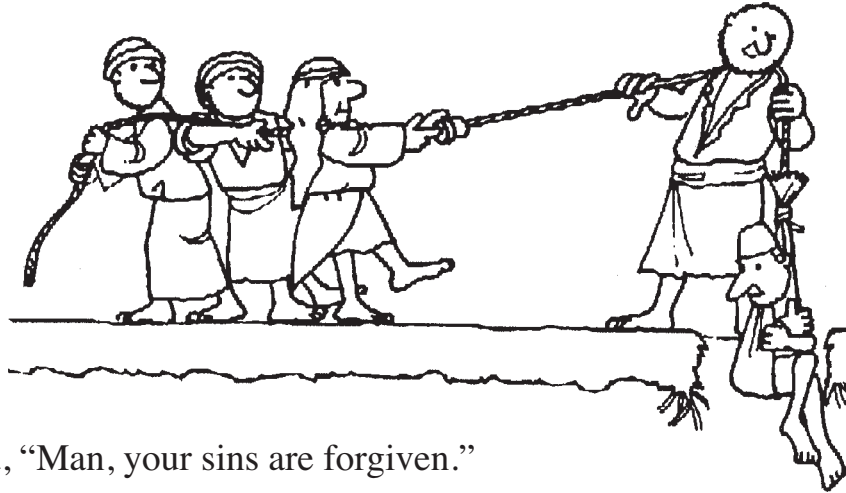
Luke 5: 17-26
