Jesus helping a man who trusted Him


A blind man was sitting at the edge of the road. He was begging, hoping that a kind person would give him some money.


I'm sure you like to go for a picnic or barbecue. It's good fun to eat outside on a warm day.



To whom did Jairus go for help? J _ _ _ _ _


