When they met, they had a long talk. Nicodemus was very puzzled when the Lord Jesus told him that he needed to be “born again” in order to enter God’s Kingdom.

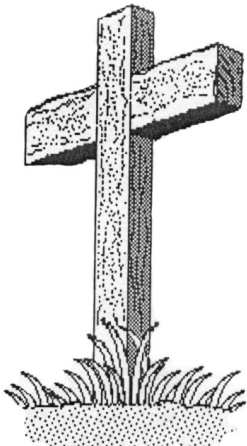
The Lord Jesus said,

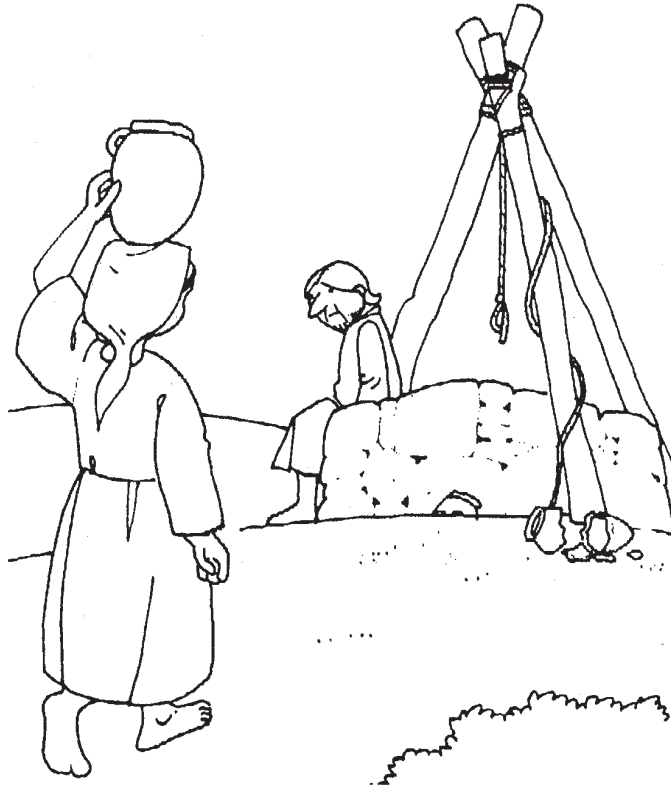
