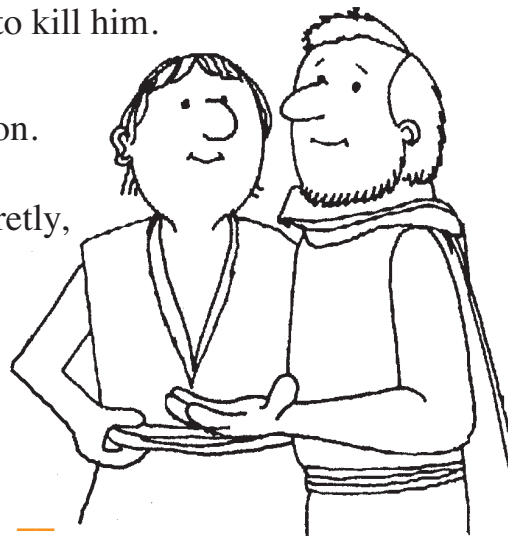


1 Samuel 20: 1-42

David did not want to get even with Saul. He was willing to forgive Saul for all the wrong he had done to him.

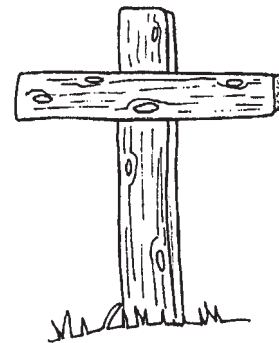

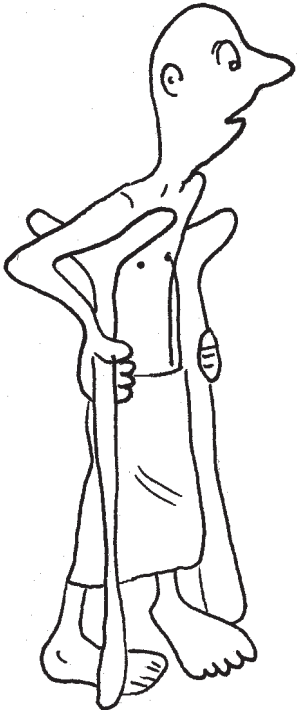
