God punishing a sinful king


Elijah lived when there was a very wicked king in Israel. The king's name was Ahab. The queen, who was called Jezebel, was also very wicked.



God chose Elijah to be His prophet. God told Elijah what to say to the king.


One day, God sent Elijah to Ahab to tell him that God would not allow any rain or dew to fall on his country for a long time!

One day, God sent Elijah back to King Ahab.

“Come with me to Mount Carmel,” said Elijah to the king. “Bring with you the prophets of the heathen god, Baal. We will have a test to show who is the true God.”
