Lesson No. 1 - God creates the world






"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth",

We, too, have to choose between right and wrong and, like Adam and Eve, we often make the wrong choice!


That evening, God wanted to talk to Adam and Eve, but they knew they had disobeyed God and they hid from Him.

Their sin had spoiled God's creation and ruined their friendship with God.


Sin always spoils things. As well as making us sad, it destroys God's world.
