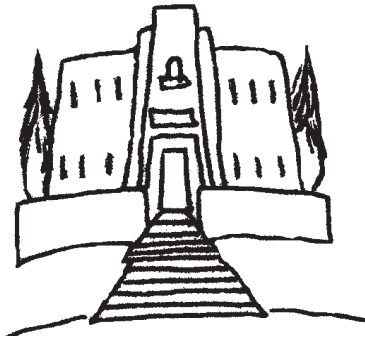

The angel Gabriel then told Zechariah that because he had not believed, he would be unable to speak until the baby was born.

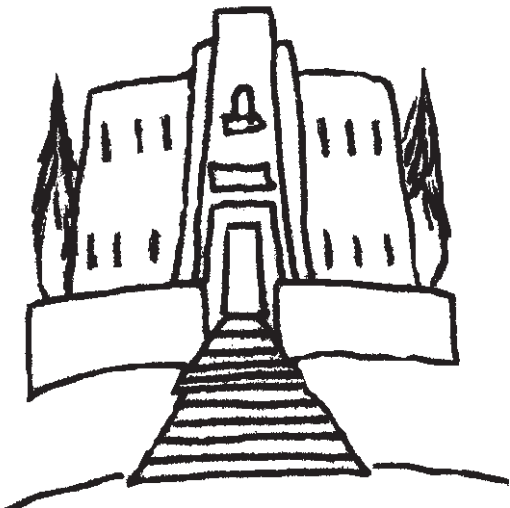

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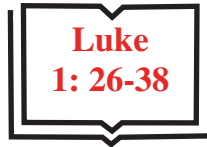

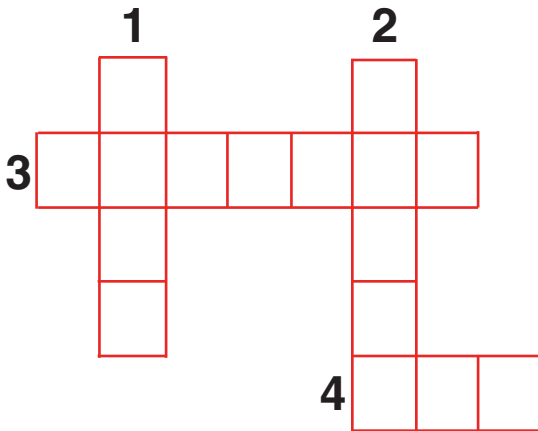
It was an exciting time; Zechariah and Elizabeth were going to have a baby, and now the angel Gabriel had another announcement to make.

Names are very important.



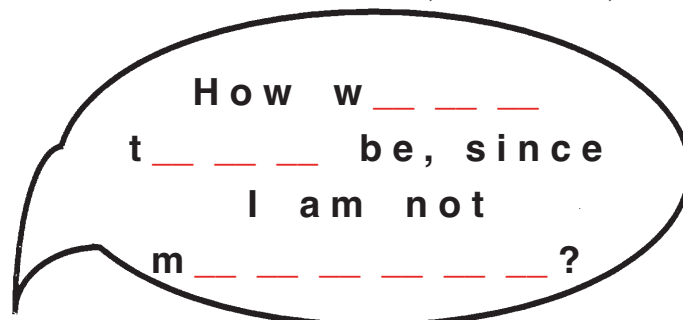

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The angel explained that God the Holy Spirit would come upon her. A miracle would take place and her child would be truly the Son of God.

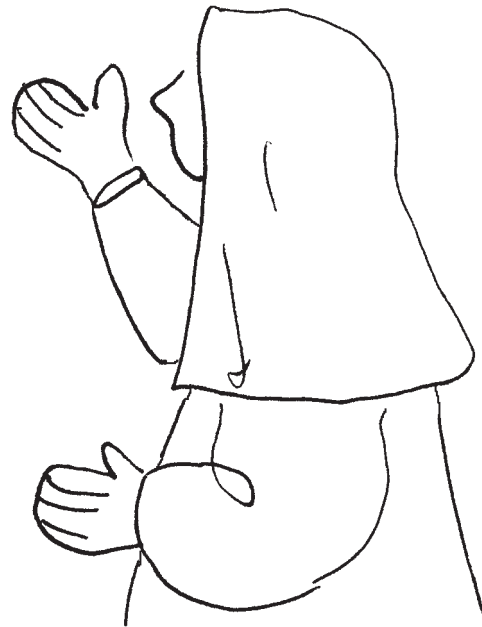

Eventually Elizabeth's baby was born. He was the son whom God had promised.

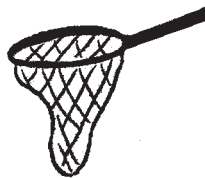
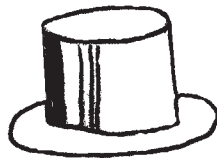
The family and neighbours came to congratulate them and everybody was happy.

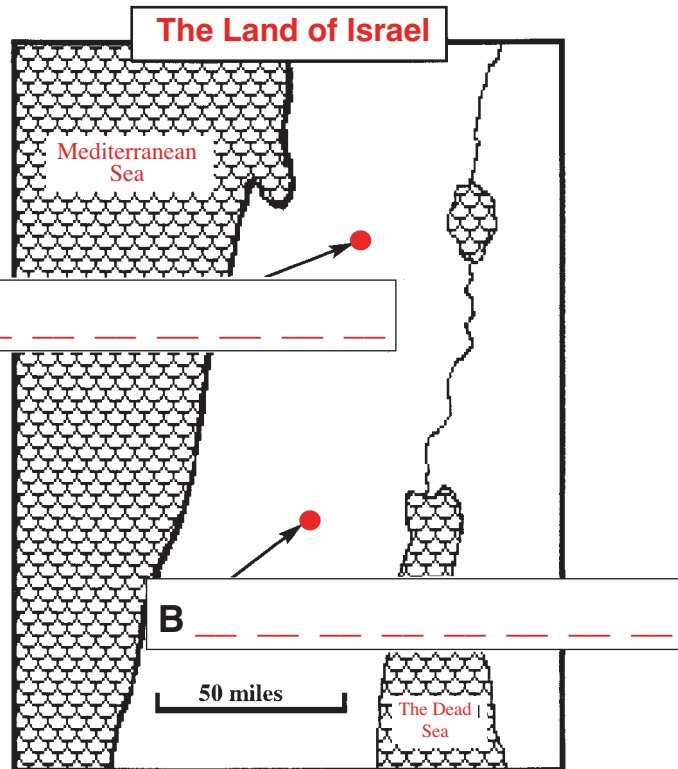

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When they arrived at Bethlehem, it was so crowded that it was difficult to find anywhere to stay. There was no room in the inn, but they eventually found a place where they could stay.

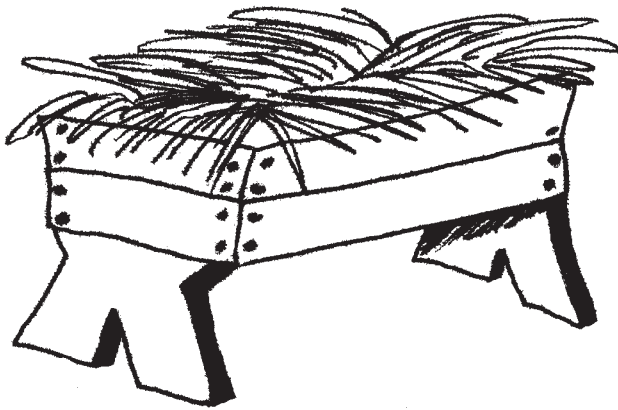
