At last, after a lot of hard work, the Ark was finished.

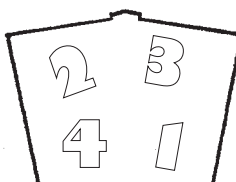

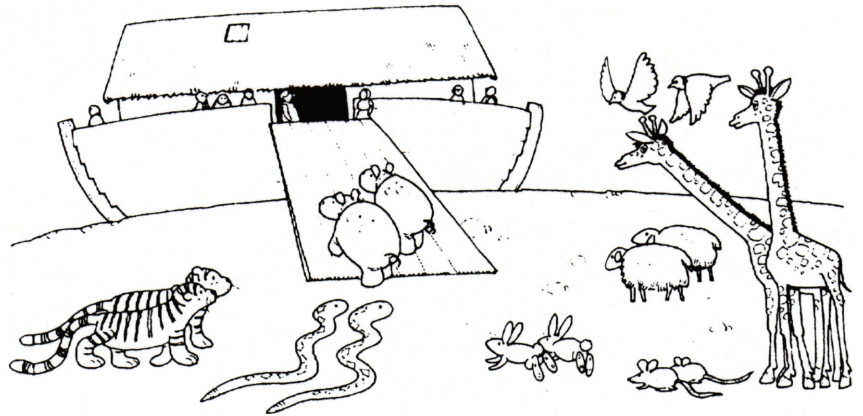

What a sad thing it is when people forget about God and live only to please themselves!

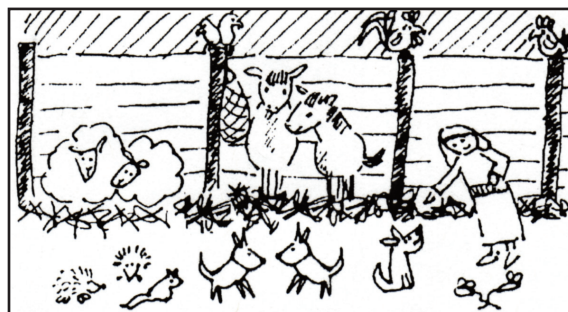
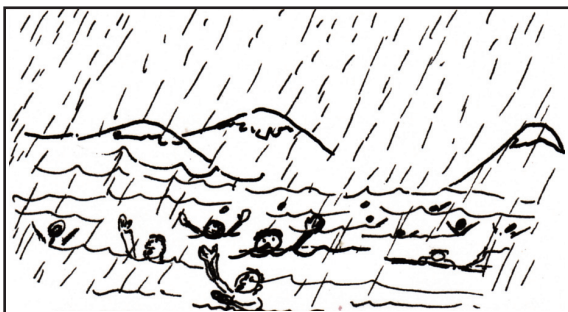

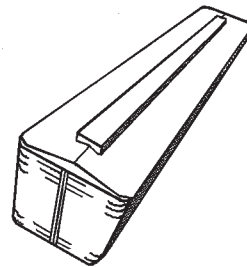
Inside the Ark, Noah, his family and all the animals were safe! Because Noah had trusted and obeyed God, He was protecting them all.

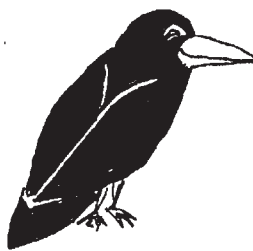

Noah and his family were safe!

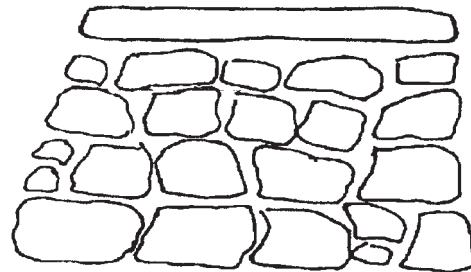
They had been in the Ark for a long time, but now God said that Noah, his family and the animals could leave the Ark.

God was very pleased that Noah and his family remembered to thank Him. He then gave them a wonderful promise.

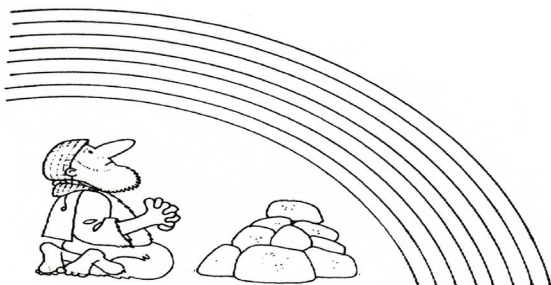
