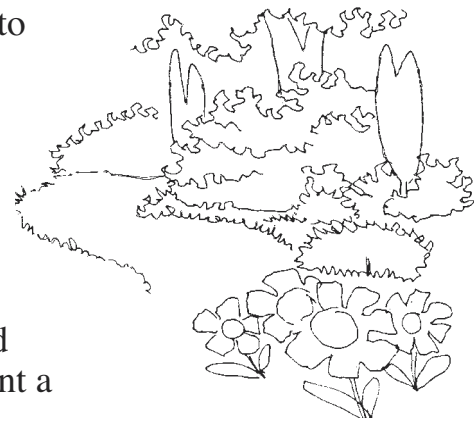

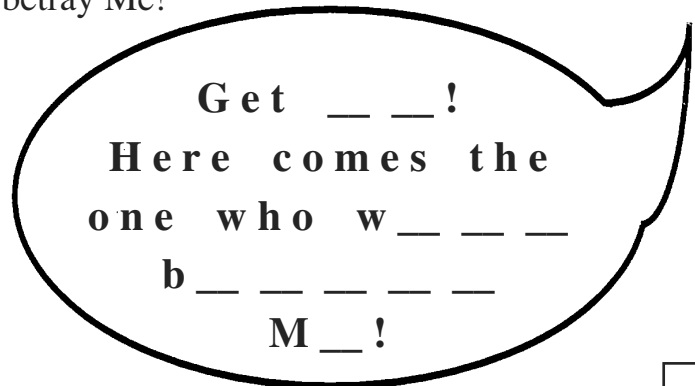

Lesson No. 2 - Peter fighting

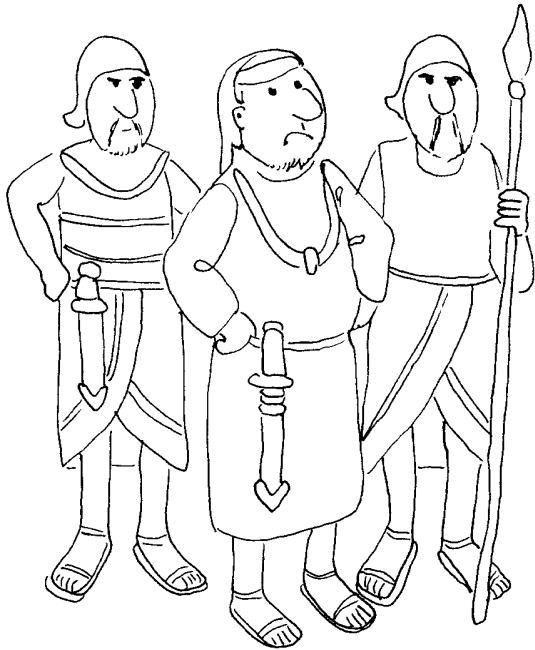
