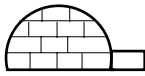

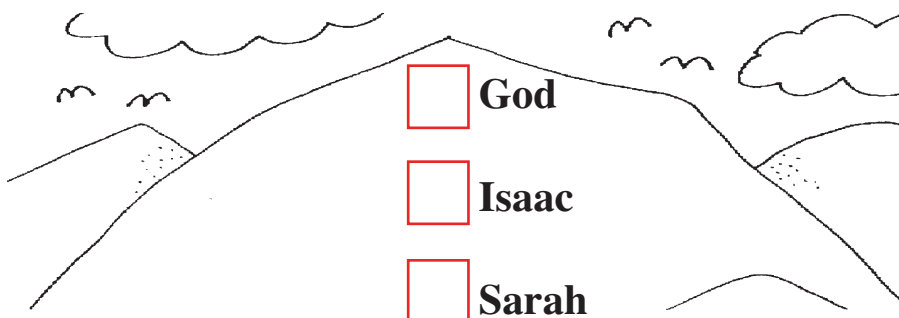
God kept His promise to Abraham and Sarah and gave them a son.



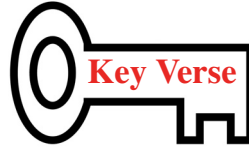

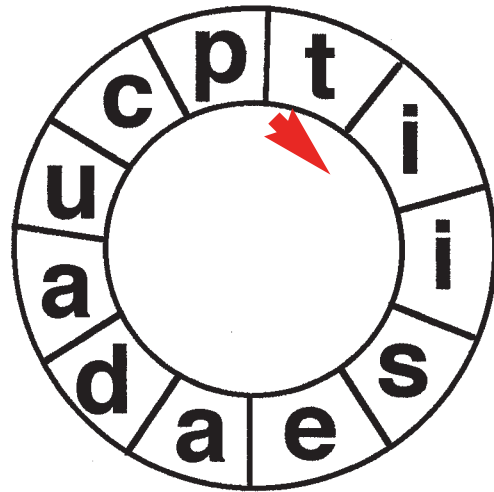

Starting at the letter 't', and going in the direction of the arrow, write down **every other** letter to find out what Abraham did on the mountain.

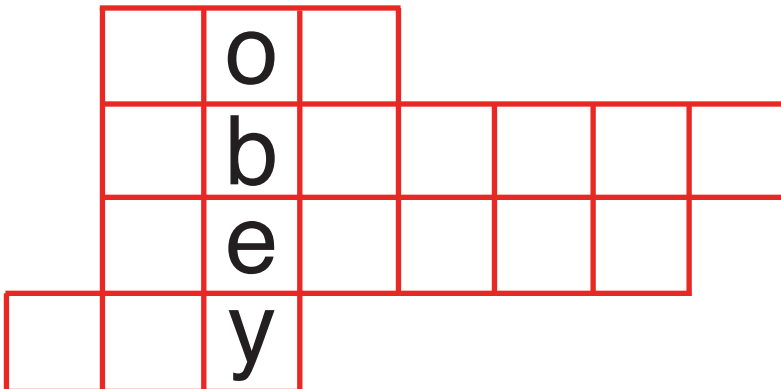

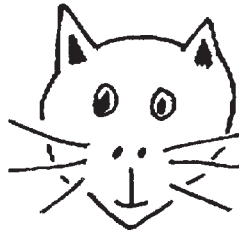
